SALUTATIONS - There are five Fridays during lent when we honor the Blessed Theotokos (Mother of God) with a most beautiful service. The icon of the Theotokos is surrounded by fresh flowers along with the Altar table.

ANNUNCIATION OF THE VIRGIN MARY - This great holy day, March 25, when the Archangel Gabriel announced to the Blessed Virgin the plan of God for the salvation of mankind is a most singular day. Her icon will again be decorated with flowers along with the Altar table.

SUNDAY OF THE VENERATION OF THE CROSS - On the third Sunday of Lent (April 2) the Church offers us the Precious Cross in adoration. It is covered with hundreds of spring flowers.

EASTER/PASCHA - The Iconostasis and the Altar area.
